## Site SupervisorTraining Action Plan!

Professional counseling standards (e.g., American School Counselor Association, Association for Counselor Education and Supervision, American Counseling Association, Council for the Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs, Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation) call for school counseling site supervisors to be trained to effectively provide oversight and opportunities for practical skill development of counselors in training.



However, site supervisors are often untrained or insufficiently trained which consequently affects efficacy in working with counselors in training (Brown et al., 2017). Furthermore, new school counselors report lack of training related to establishing comprehensive school counseling services in graduate programs.
